

PERSONAL GEAR CHECKLIST FOR WEEKEND CAMPING

TROOP 101

Rochester Hills, Michigan

GENERAL

- Put your name and troop number on EVERYTHING so it can be returned if / when found after you misplace/lose it.
- Pack everything into a backpack or duffel bag that you can carry 1 mile from the parking lot to the campsite.
- Pack everything YOURSELF so you know what you have and where it is!
- Ask yourself: what will you wear if it is: hot/sunny, wet/rainy, windy / cold, snowy, buggy, etc? Remember, it could be 45 degrees and rainy!
- Ask yourself: what will I wear during the day, during the night?
- Ask yourself: do I have what I need to stay warm / cool / dry, to eat, to sleep?
- See the checklists in the Scout Handbook.

GEAR

- Backpack or Duffel Bag
- Rain Cover for backpack
- Day Pack or Fanny Pack
- Pillow
- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad
- Rain Jacket & Rain Pants
- Water Bottle
- Whistle
- Compass
- Pocket Knife or Multi-Tool (Leatherman/Gerber) and Totin' Chip
- 50' Nylon Cord (for clothesline)
- Cup
- Dish (such as a Gladware sandwich container)
- Spoon
- Fork
- Scout Handbook
- Troop 'Class B' T-shirts
- Troop Hat
- Flashlight & Batteries (many of us prefer headlamps)
- First Aid Kit (personal size: bandaids, moleskin, any special needs you have, etc.)

CLOTHING (Appropriate for the season / weather)

- Underwear (wear 1 pair and bring 1 extra pair)
- Shorts/Pants (1 pair - many scouts like the convertibles)
- Shirts (wear 1 and bring 1 extra)
- Long Sleeve Shirts (1 or 2)
- Swimsuit (if swimming is part of the program)
- Jacket/Shell

OTHER

- Notebook, Pens, Pencils
- Money (for snack / meal stops on the way there and back)
- Watch
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent

OPTIONAL

- Sunglasses
- Camera (disposable)
- Fishing Gear
- Books or Magazines
- Playing Cards and / or Games (chess, etc.)
- Camp Stool or Chair
- Trekking Poles

NOT RECOMMENDED

- Personal Music Players - not recommended
- Mobile Phone - not recommended
- GameBoy - not recommended

- Food from Home - help plan your patrol's menu and eat with the group!
